Those of limited financial resources have a right to public funding for family planning and abortion services.			
There shall be no waiting period to obtain an abortion.			
There shall be no legal requirement for parental notification or consent prior to a person under 18 obtaining reproductive health care services, including birth control or abortion.			
FDA-approved emergency contraception shall be offered without delay to all victims of rape or incest in all hospitals or clinics.			
FDA-approved emergency contraception shall be provided to any person who could become pregnant, without delay or obstruction, at all pharmacies in the United States.			

FDA-approved medicated abortion (e.g. Mifepristone, misoprostol, and others) shall be provided to any pregnant person in the United States, without delay or obstruction.			
Reproductive health care services, including birth control and abortion, shall be easily accessible within all U.S. states and territories and shall never require traveling across state lines.			
Comprehensive, medically accurate, age-appropriate sex education shall be provided.
